The proposed mural is titled “Tribute to Margarita”. The mural is anticipated to last 10 years. Some fading may occur over time due to UV exposure. The artist can touch up the work when necessary. This mural design was created through collaboration and curation between the artist, Backfence Society, and Judy Pantazo with the Friends of The Rancho Buena Vista Adobe.

The wall measures approximately 25' long x 14' high. The artist will finalize colors, but will be sepia tones and muted pastels. High acrylic paint will be used and mural will be hand painted on wall.

Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed mural to be painted on the building wall located at 110 South Citrus Avenue, Vista, during the public viewing period which will occur from February 22, 2018 to March 27, 2018.
