



NOTICE INVITING BIDS

PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board, Buena Sanitation District (“Agency”) for furnishing all plant, labor, services, materials, tools, equipment, supplies, transportation, utilities and all other items and facilities necessary therefore, as provided in the Contract Documents, for the “BUENA OUTFALL FORCEMAIN PHASE III, CIP No. 8131” in strict accordance with the Project Specifications and Plans on file in the Buena Sanitation District’s Engineering Department.

1. DATE OF OPENING BIDS

Bids will be received at the Office of the Clerk of the Board, located on the second floor of the Vista Civic Center, 200 Civic Center Drive, Vista, California 92084-6275, until 2:00 P.M., Tuesday, May 1, 2018, at which time and place the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

Note: The Buena Sanitation District complies with the American Disabilities Act. If you require reasonable accommodations for the bid opening, please contact the Office of the Clerk of the Board, (760) 639-6125, at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the bid opening.

2. DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Without intending to limit the content of the scope of services expected to be performed by the Contractor, the Work generally includes installing 10,300 LF of 24-inch and 2,700 LF of 26-inch butt fused C906 HDPE (DR 11) sewer forcemain. Additionally, 4,200 LF of 24-inch, 1,500 LF of 30-inch and 150 LF of 16-inch butt fused C906 HDPE (DR 17) sewer gravity pipeline will be installed. All HDPE pipelines shall be butt fused unless otherwise noted. There will be three (3) odor control facility sites along the project alignment to treat noxious gases, of which two (2) will require new SDG&E metering service, new water service and meter, and a variation of 2” \varnothing , 4” \varnothing , 6” \varnothing and 8” \varnothing PVC drain and foul air piping as denoted on the Plans. Additionally, Site No. 1 and No. 2 will require a new CMU block structure around the proposed odor scrubber with internals as denoted on the Plans.

A total of seventeen (17) 5-ft \varnothing manholes will be installed along the gravity sewer pipeline segments. A total of nineteen (19) 6-ft \varnothing access manholes with 24--in \varnothing blind outlet shall be installed along the forcemain pipeline segments. Two (2) 6-ft \varnothing forcemain termination / gravity sewer transition manholes will be located at the ends of the two forcemain segments of this project. Two (2) 5-ft \varnothing pressure manhole shafts and pressure plates are to be installed at the lower reaches of the upper gravity sewer as the flows transition from open channel to pressurized. The westernmost segments gravity sewer pipeline will be split at the proposed flow diversion structure where the flows will be diverted to either the Buena Outfall or the Vallecitos Outfall. To accommodate the proposed split outfall, 2 connection manholes with cast-in-place bases will be

installed around the live, active and operational 30-in \varnothing Buena and 39-in \varnothing Vallecitos outfall pipelines. Upstream of the outfall connections, two (2) new vortex drop inserts will be furnished and installed in a precast 7-ft \varnothing and 6-ft \varnothing drop manhole structure (respectively). During start-up activities, the existing Buena and Vallecitos pipelines inside the connection manholes will be removed to accept flow.

A cast-in-place concrete diversion structure will split flows into the two respective outfalls and provide isolation benefit with two (2) internal downward opening weir gates. The project will install flow monitoring devices at the west connection downstream of the flow diversion structure which will be maintained through existing Encina contracts with ADS Environmental.

The eastern interconnection will require connection to the existing Buena Outfall 24" PVC (blind wye). Additionally, trenchless horizontal jacking and auger boring with manned entry to install a 40" steel casing pipeline under El Camino Real and the utilities within El Camino Real. The eastern connection of the Buena Outfall forcemain will require a coordinated shutdown of the existing Buena Outfall pipeline with the Owner. All three of the odor facilities including the east and west interconnection locations will require new utility and construction easements acquisition. Pipeline trench patch, asphalt resurfacing and striping along with restoration and repairs to concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, and irrigation facilities shall be performed by the Contractor as required and per the Contract Documents.

3. LOCATION OF WORK

The Work to be constructed for C.I.P. No. 8131 is at the following locations:
Paseo Del Norte between Camino De Las Ondas and Palomar Airport Road in the City of Carlsbad
Palomar Airport Road between Paseo Del Norte and El Camino Real in the City of Carlsbad

4. CONSTRUCTION COST OPINION AND TIME OF COMPLETION

The Agency's Estimate of Probable Construction Cost for this Project is Nine Million Nine Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$9,935,000) for the base bid items and N/A for the alternate bid items.

All work shall be completed within Three Hundred Forty (340) calendar days after the date of the Notice to Proceed.

The Agency will enforce Liquidated Damages based on the conditions and time constraints specified in Section 6-9.

5. CONTRACTOR'S LICENSE CLASSIFICATION

In accordance with the provisions of the California Public Contract Code Section 3300, the Agency has determined that the Contractor shall be required to possess at a minimum a valid California Class A General Engineering Contractor License at the time that the Contract is awarded, and shall maintain said license in good standing at all times during performance of the Work.

Only General Contractors who have been prequalified for this project by the City of Vista based on the City's Request for Prequalifications dated May 17, 2016, will be eligible to bid for this project.

6. CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

A shipping fee, payable in advance, for each set of the Contract Documents to be mailed is an additional TWENTY FIVE DOLLARS (\$25.00).

7. PRE-BID MEETING

An optional Pre-Bid meeting will be conducted by the Agency on Wednesday, April 11, 2018, starting at 10:00 A.M. at the Vista Civic Center - Vista Conference Room at 200 Civic Center Drive, Vista, CA. A site visit will not be conducted.

Prospective Bidders must provide their own transportation.

During the pre-bid meeting, the scope of the Project and the bidding requirements will be reviewed by the Agency and comments and questions from prospective Bidders will be discussed. Prospective Bidders are encouraged to attend.
