

Benefits of Licensing

- Licensed pets are more likely to be reunited with their owners if they become lost.
- Your licensing fee provides care to stray and homeless animals and helps eliminate animal cruelty in Oceanside and Vista.
- Important health information about your pet can be placed in their licensing records.
- Licensing provides proof of animal ownership.
- It's the law. Both cities of Oceanside (City Code 4.17) and Vista (Municipal Code 6.07.010) require all dogs 4+ months to be licensed. Failure to comply could result in an administrative citation.

Steps to Licensing

- Complete the licensing form on the other side or download more at www.sdhumane.org.
- Provide proof of current rabies vaccine. The license cannot exceed the rabies vaccine expiration date.
- Provide proof of alteration (i.e. Spay/Neuter); otherwise owner will be charged the unaltered rate.
- Mail payment to or come into the North Campus. Open daily from 10am-5pm.

The North Campus hosts the **Project KEPPT Rabies Vaccine Clinic** on the 1st Sunday of each month from 1pm-3pm at 572 Airport Road, Oceanside, CA 92058.

Licensing Perks for Oceanside and Vista Residents



Fast Track: Found pets will be quickly reunited with their owner or rushed to an appropriate veterinarian if severely injured.



Free Ride Home: The first time a licensed pet is picked up, it will receive a free ride home, skipping a trip to SDHS.




Extended Stay: When found, your licensed pet will be cared for by a veterinarian at the shelter for up to 14 days prior to putting up for adoption.



Vacation Pet Alert: When you leave home for vacation, register your pet with the contact information of who is caring for the pet. This will allow for the Extended Stay piece to go into effect.

*Owner must provide proof of sterilization (i.e. spay/neuter) from a CA-certified veterinarian.

**Must provide proof of current out-of-area license in order to transfer. Valid for maximum of 1-yr.

Applicable City Codes:

- 🐾 All applicable animals are required to be vaccinated against rabies and licensed within 30-days...

 - after reaching the age of (4) months, or
 - of acquiring the animal, or
 - after entering the jurisdiction of these ordinances.
- 🐾 Failure to obtain a license is a misdemeanor and may result in a fine.
- 🐾 Rabies vaccination must be effective through the entire licensing period (i.e. the license *cannot* exceed the rabies expiration date).
- 🐾 License tags shall be firmly attached to the animal's collar and worn at all times.
- 🐾 License fees are not refundable or transferable to another owner.
