

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC ART

The City of Vista's Public Art Commission is seeking public input on wall two of the three walls in the Paseo Santa Fe downtown district. The art walls are located in the linear park adjacent to 325 S. Santa Fe Avenue, and are constructed of split face concrete block, and measure 30' by 8'.

Name of Artist: Randall Art Ranch – Rick Randall and Jaydon Sterling-Randall

The Veteran's Memorial Park commemorates Veterans who have served and in some cases given their lives to protect our country. Our art piece proposal is one in which freedom is celebrated. What demonstrates freedom more than the light-hearted joy of a child playing in the park? This freedom would not exist if it was not for the sacrifices made by the fearless men and women in which this park recognizes. This piece depicts a young girl joyfully doing cartwheels (left to right) in the park. Our goal in this piece is to express gratitude to those who serve our country, for without those brave men and women children would not play without fear in a park.

The piece will be created out of a 1/8" aluminum which would then have a grinder finish and clear coated to keep the luster of the finished piece. The young girl's pigtails would have a bright pink hair band which will add to the lighthearted aspect of the piece. Each of the five pieces would be 6 feet tall and 4 feet wide. The three pieces on the wall would be attached to the wall by brackets which could be removed if necessary. The two pieces next to the wall would be bracketed to a concrete base.



Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed project, during the public viewing period which will occur from August 11, 2016 to September 12, 2016.
