

NOTICE OF PROPOSED PLACEMENT OF PUBLIC ART


The City of Vista's Public Art Commission is seeking public input on the two mosaic glass sculptures, one for each column, located at the front entrance of the Vista Branch Library 700 Eucalyptus Avenue, Vista.

Name of Artist: Cherrie LaPorte

Type of Artwork: Two Mosaic Glass Sculptures

Title of Artwork: "Interconnection"

The mosaic will comprise of fused and stained glass on a waterproof Wedi Board. There will be two mosaic sculptures – one for each column. The size per each is approximately 4 ½ x 6 feet. The design is made of multiple colored pieces of fused glass and stained glass and will be grouted and sealed with a grout sealer on the Wedi Board.



The support frame will be a powder coated black custom steel frame. The board will have bolts installed through the Wedi Board and the metal frame for strength and anchored into the concrete wall. The exposed bolt in front will be capped with a glued piece of glass as to not show the bolt head. The sculpture will be able to be removed by unscrewing the bolts from the anchors. There will be approximately 8-10 bolts and anchors per board. Artwork maintenance will consist of cleaning glass once a year if needed and checking the integrity of the grout and glass. Sealer could be reapplied every five years for extra protection from weather.



Individuals are encouraged to view and comment on the proposed mosaic glass sculptures during the public viewing period which will occur from August 25, 2016 to September 27, 2016.
